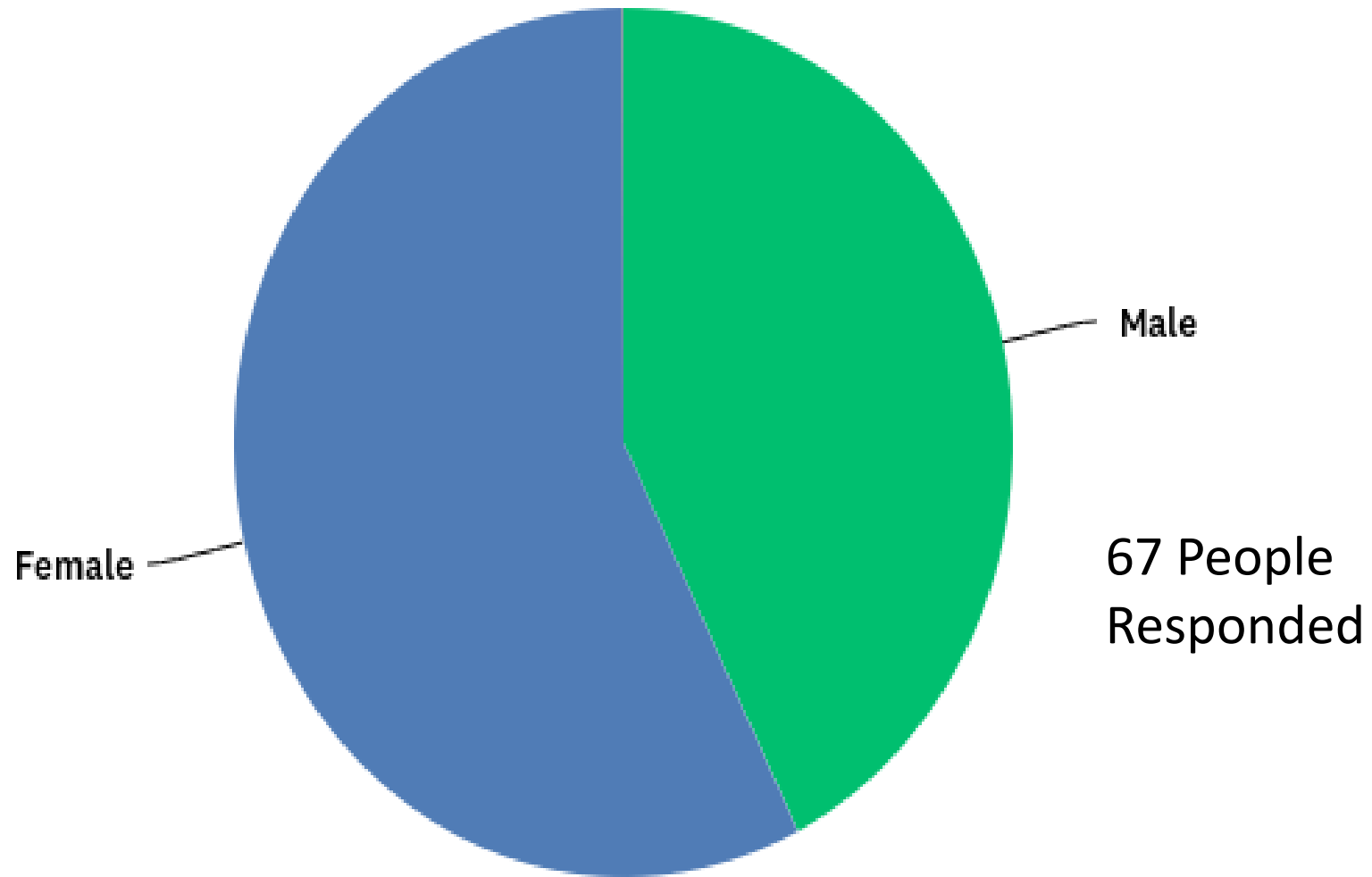

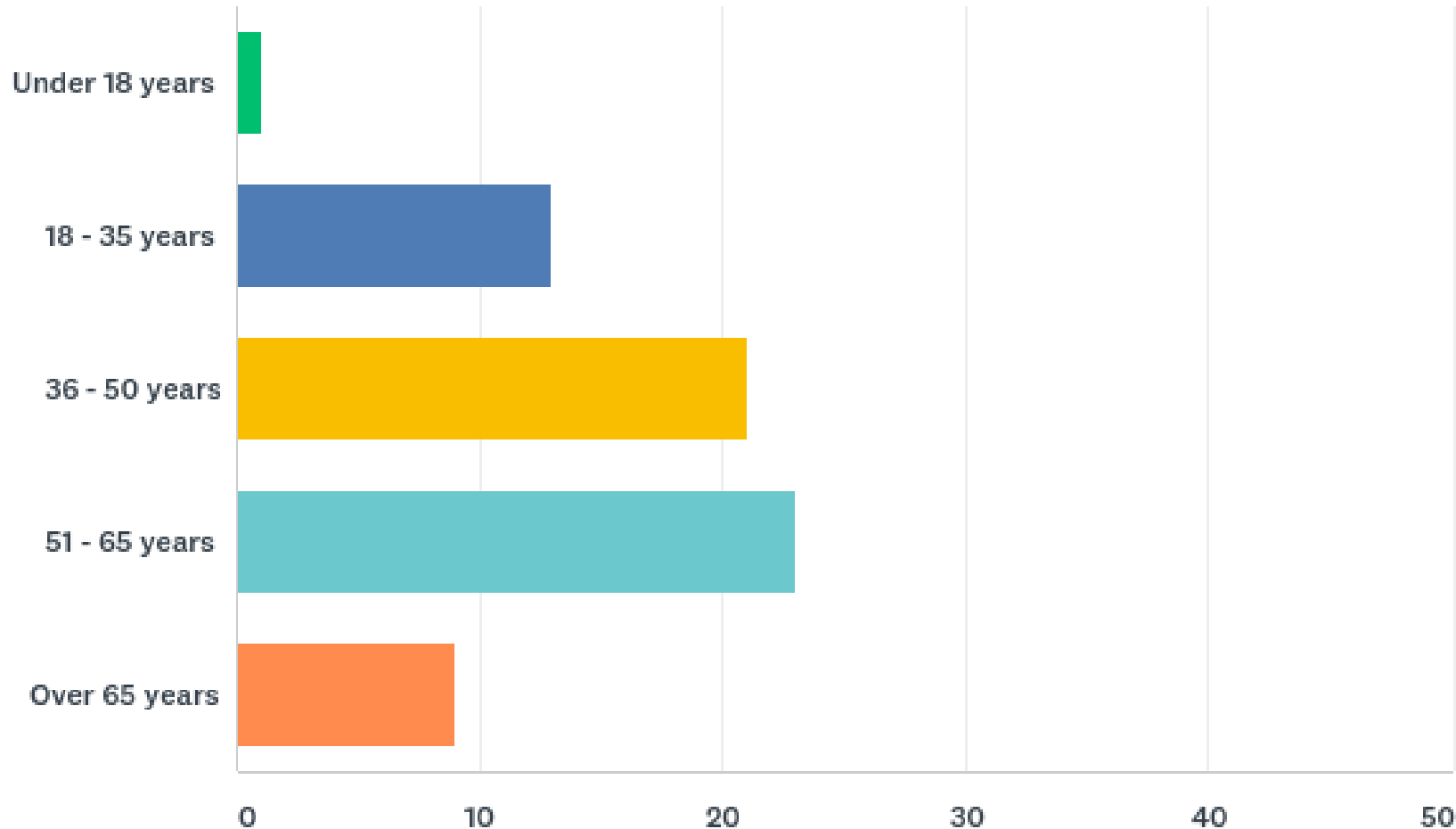

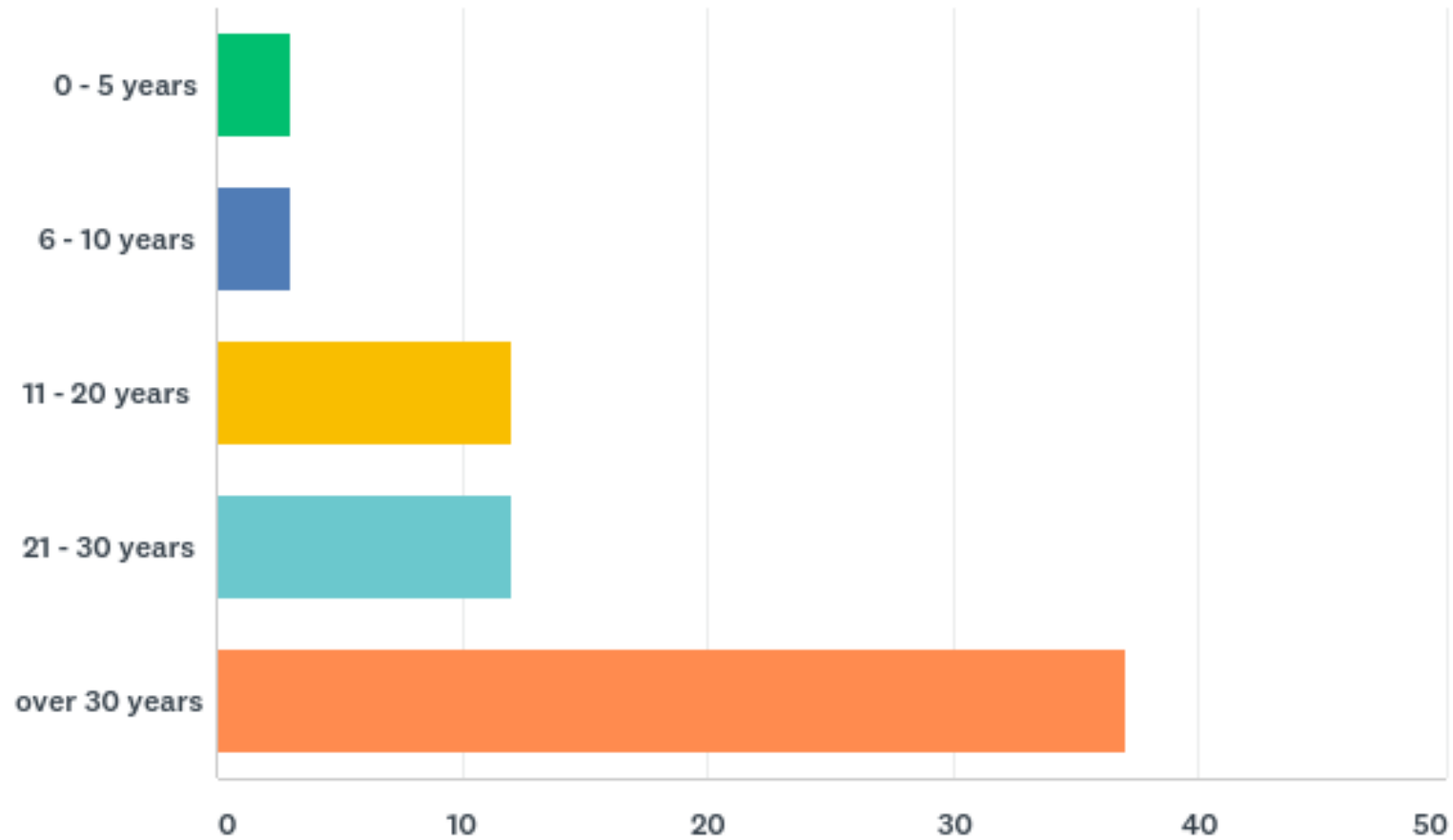
Q2. Male or Female



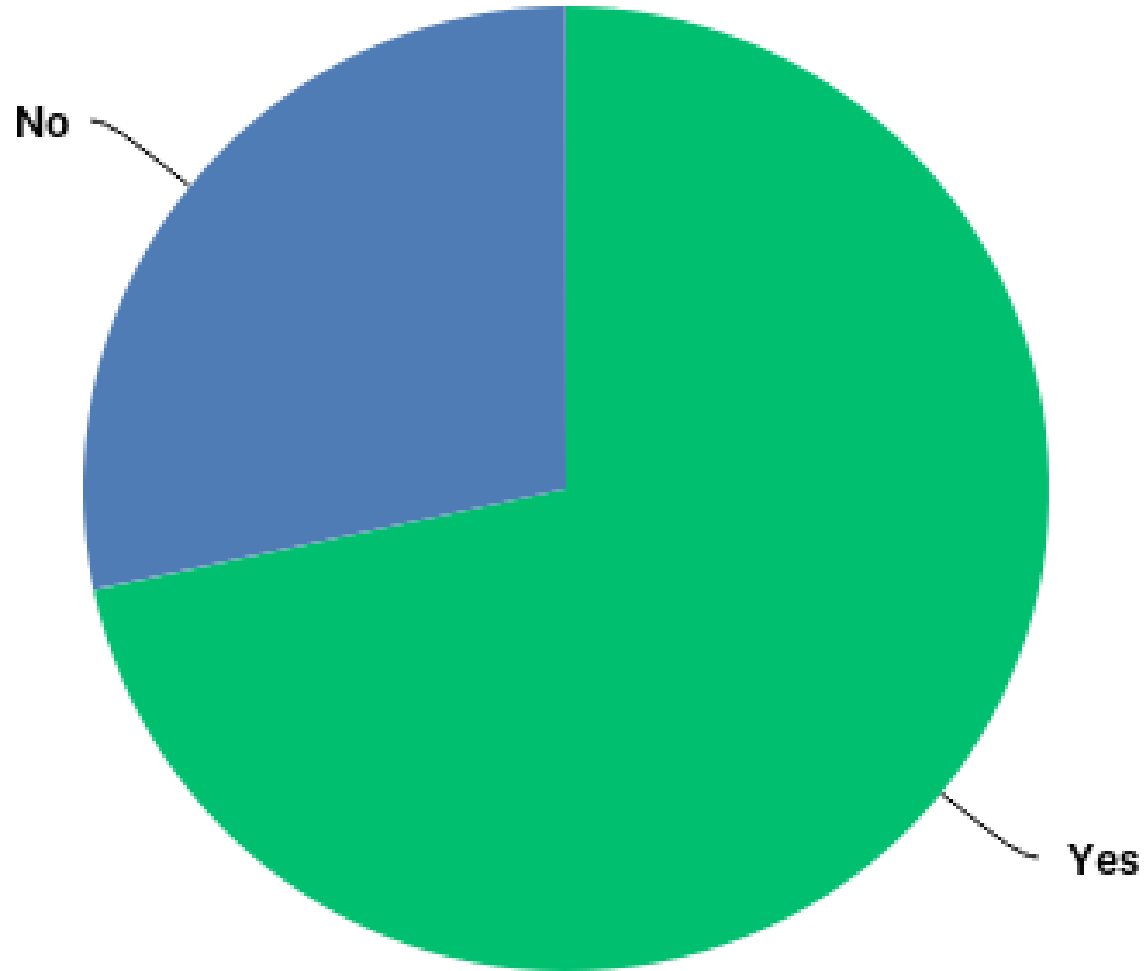
Q3. To which of the following age categories do you belong?



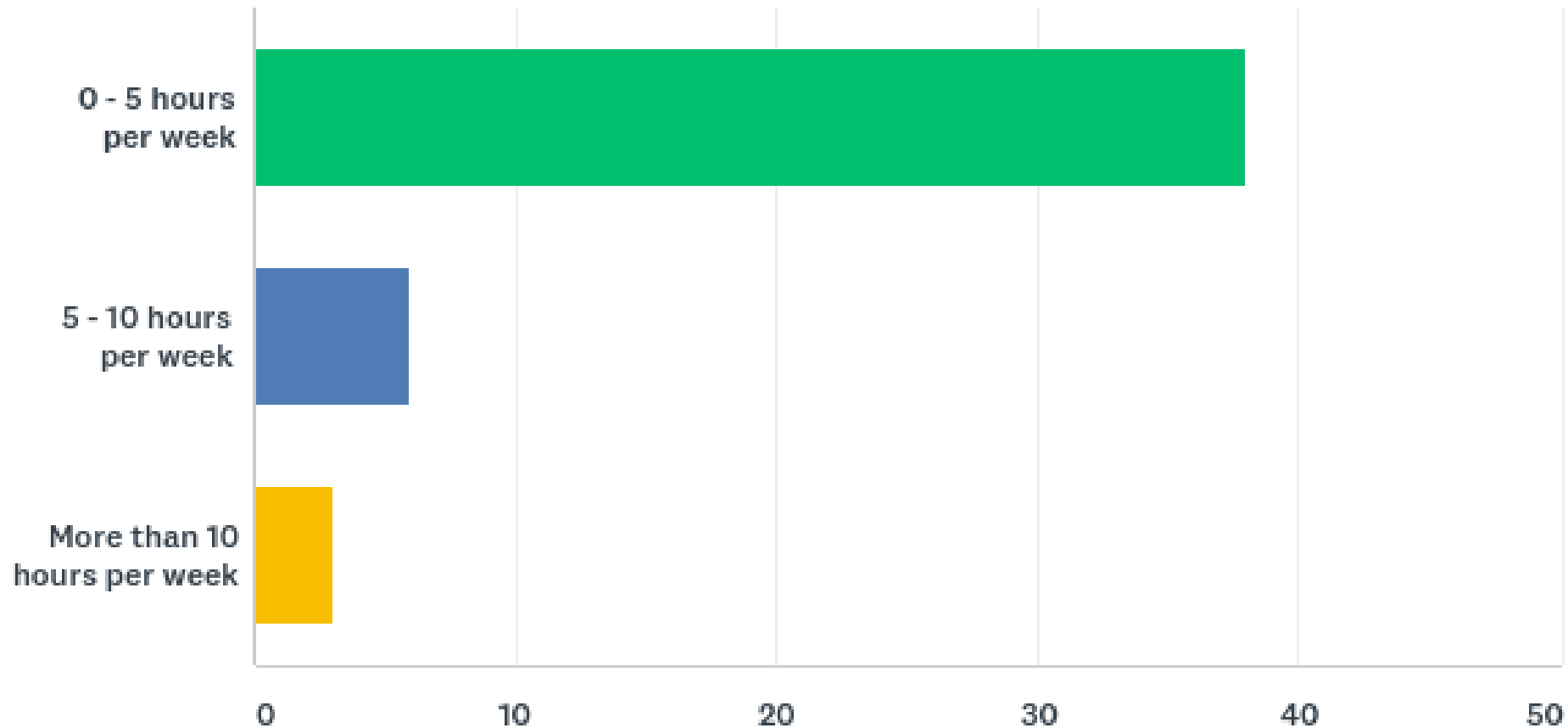
Q4. Which of the following best describes how long you have lived in this community?

- Two out of three said yes

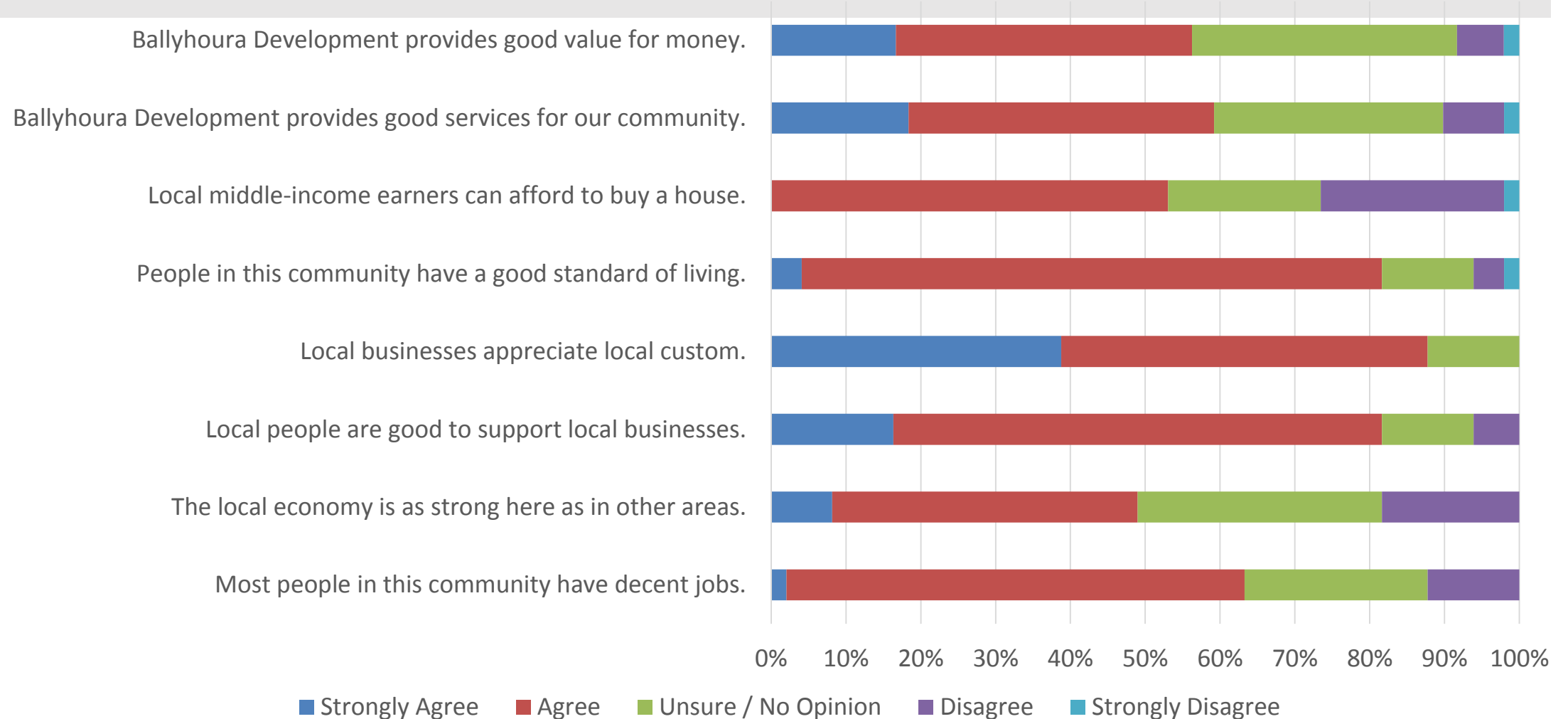

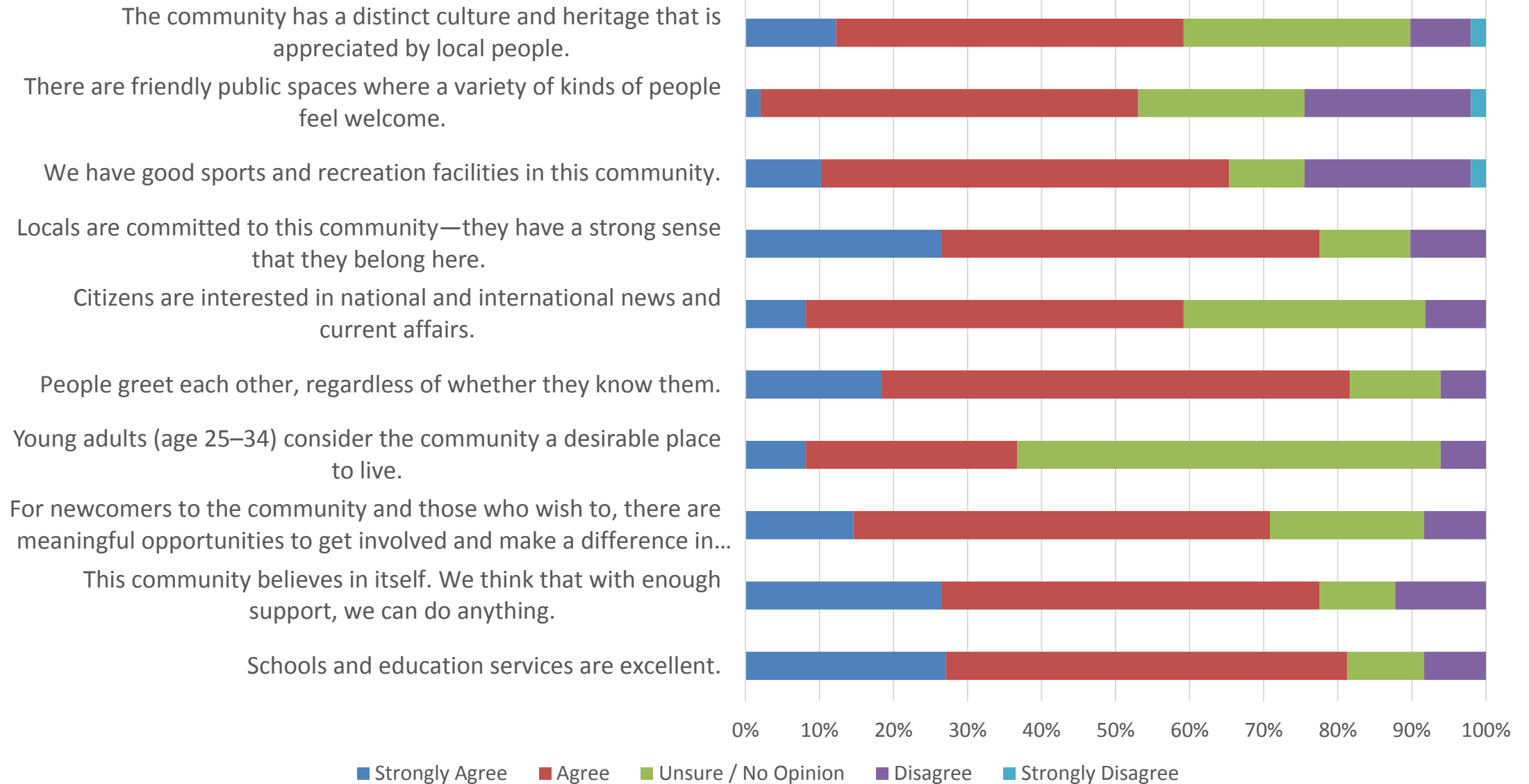

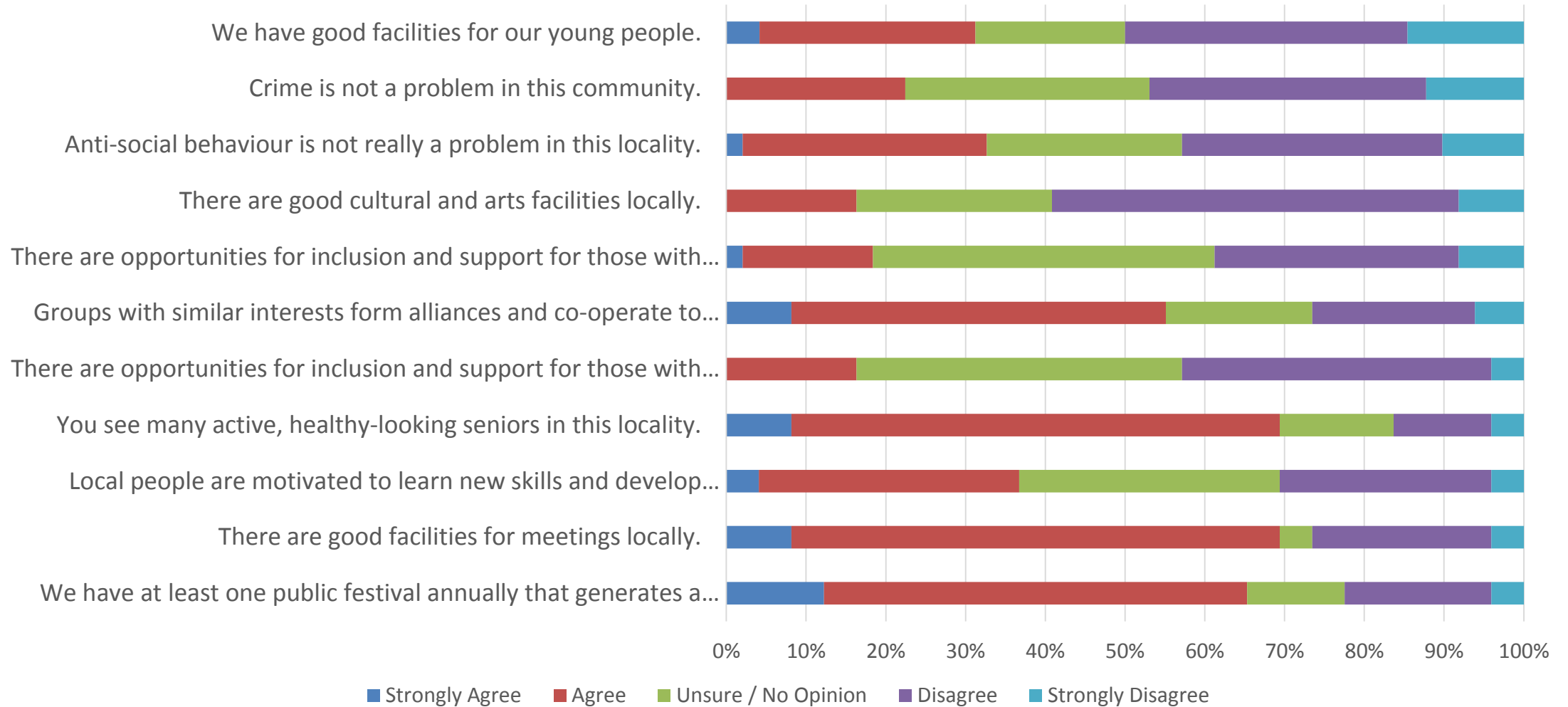

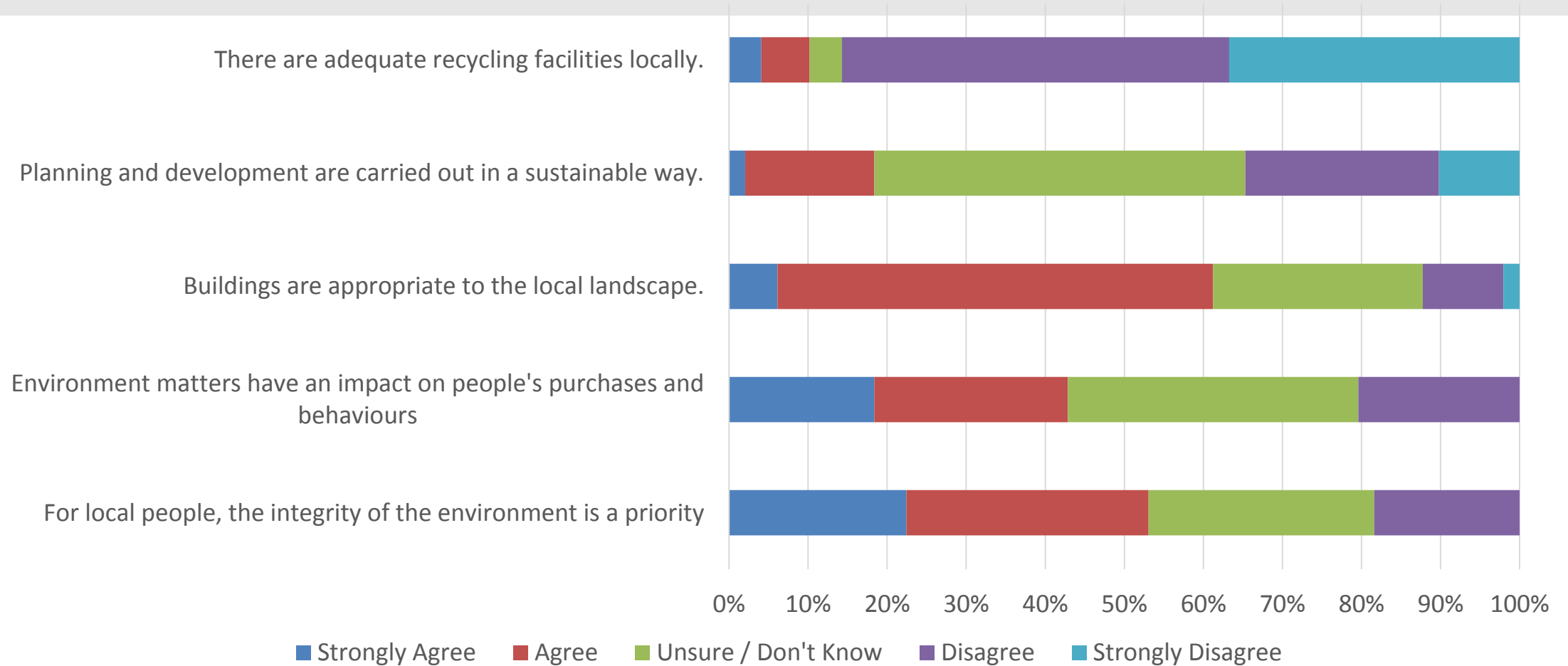
Q. 11 Social Vibrancy



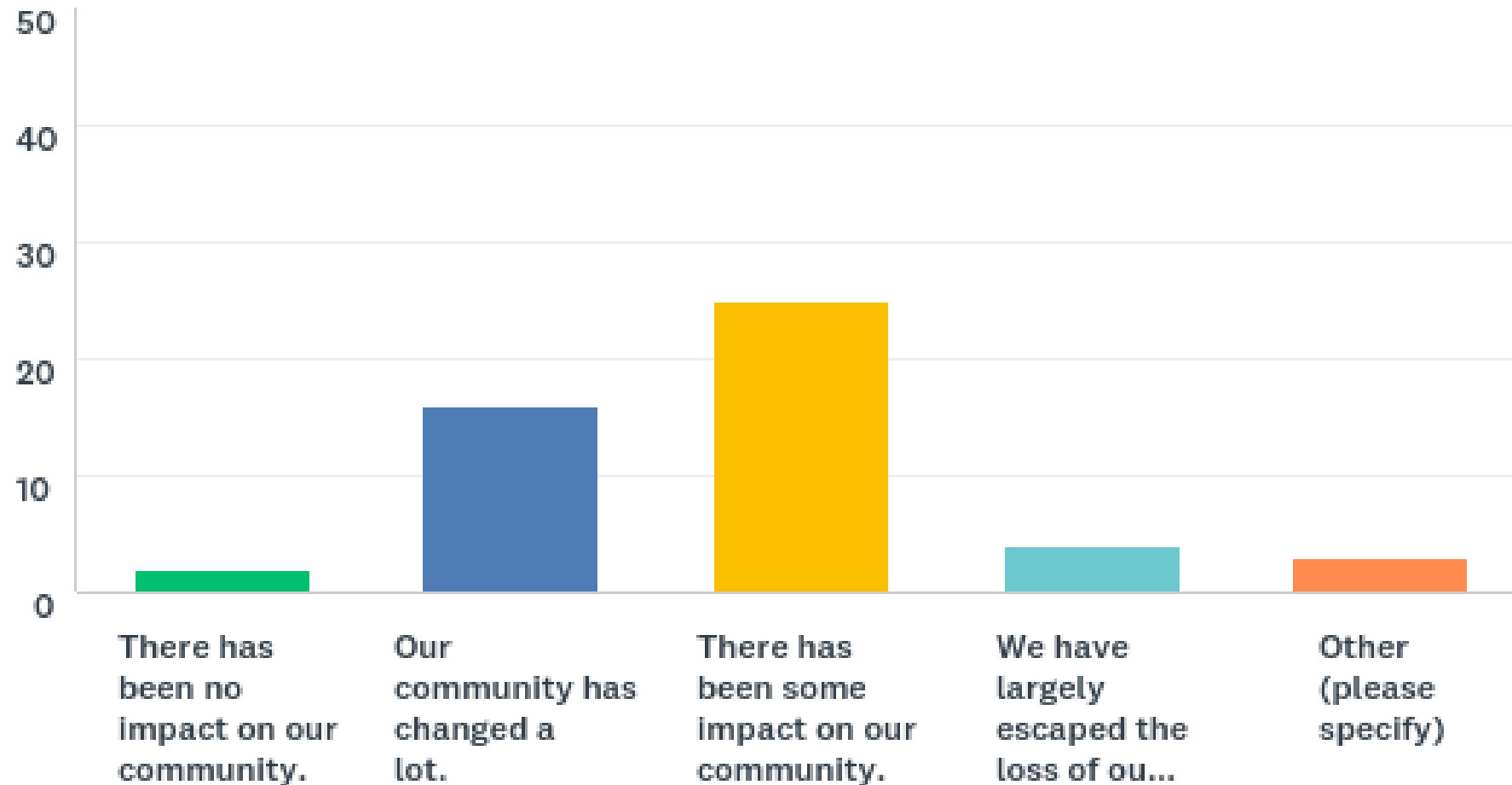

Q12 Environmental Vibrancy



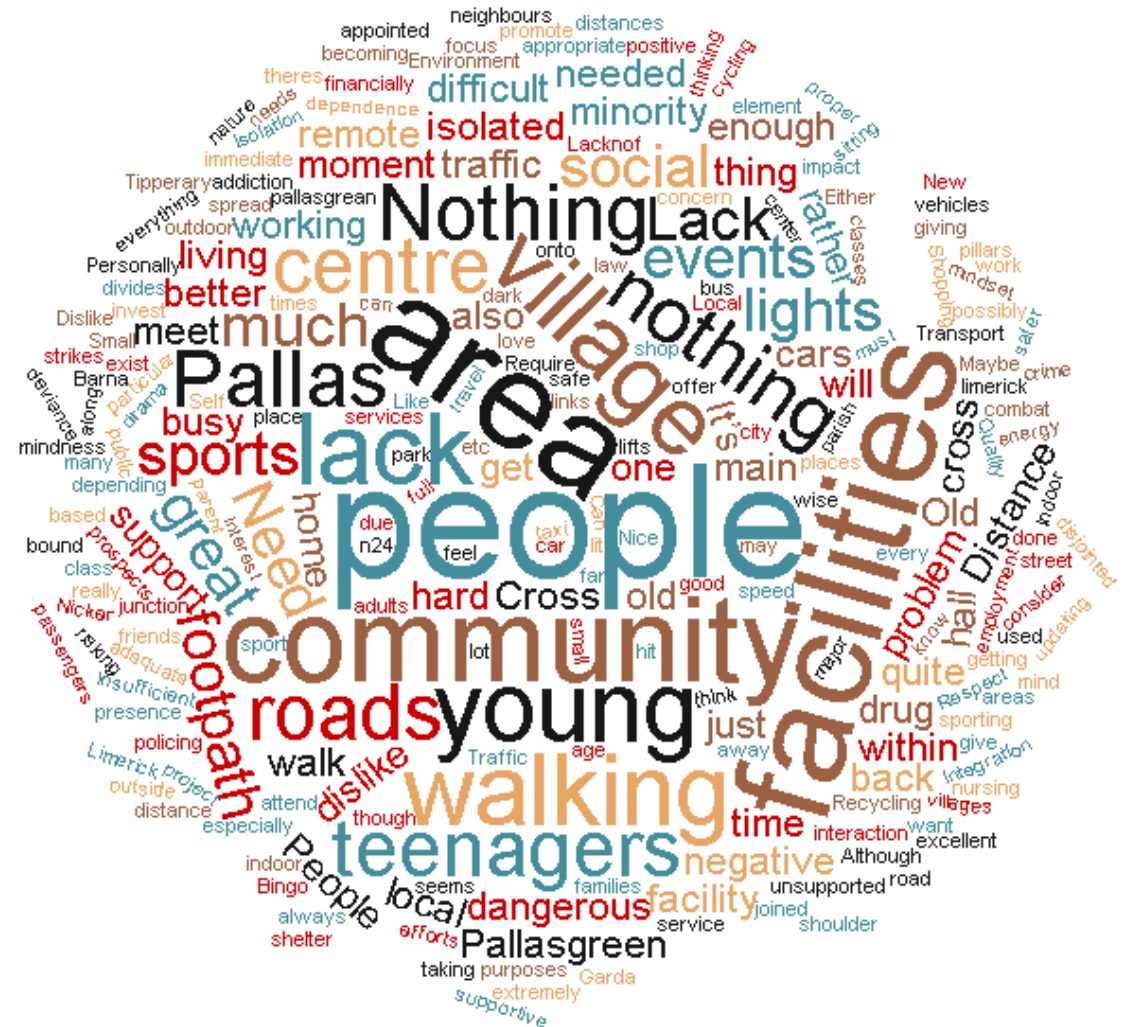
Q13. How would you describe the impact of recent population changes on your community?



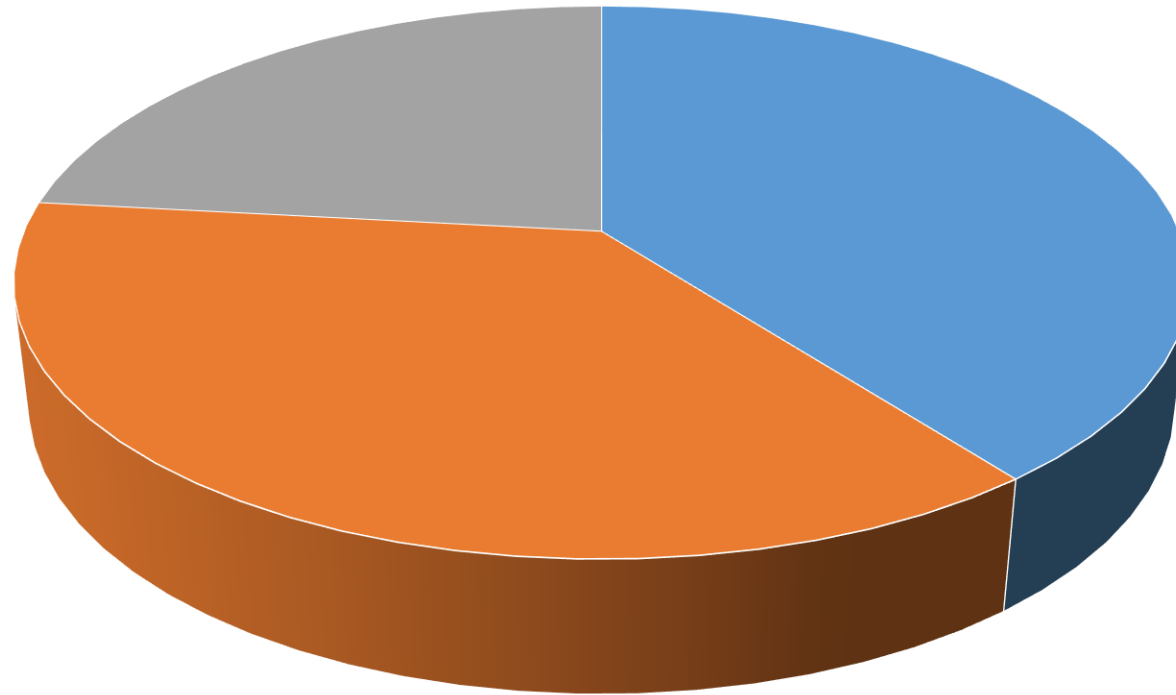
Q14. What, if anything, do you like about living in your area



Q15. What, if anything, do you dislike about living in your area?

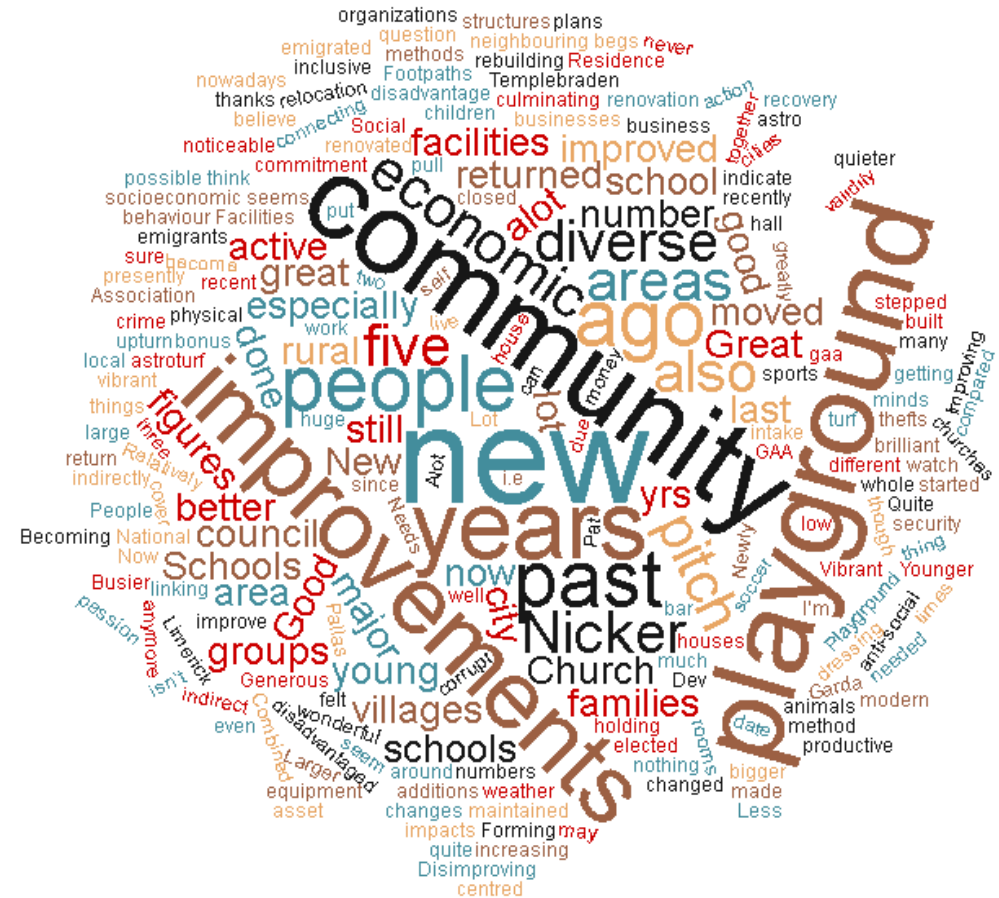


Q16. Does everyone in your community feel included?

Main Issues

6. Cultural and arts facilities seen as inadequate.
7. Development of footpaths and cycleways needed eg to Nursing Home.
